**JANUARY 3rd IS THE LAST DAY TO SIGN UP FOR SKI CLUB.**

**2020 DRYDEN SKI & BOARD CLUB REGULATIONS:**

**1. Club Fee/Transportation:** This club registration/health form and payment of \$60.00 is required to participate in the Dryden Ski Club. Participants in the Ski Club program must pay the club fee to cover supervision, transportation, and equipment. **If it is necessary for a student to ride home from Greek Peak with his/her parents, the parent must sign the official Dryden School District Transportation Release Form in the presence of a Dryden school Ski Club chaperone. At no time will a student be allowed to ride from Greek Peak with someone other than his/her parent/s, and a chaperone must be notified in advance if a student will be riding the bus back to Dryden after skiing who didn't ride the bus there. STUDENT MUST TELL A CHAPERONE IF THEY'RE RIDING HOME WITH THEIR PARENTS ON THE BUS RIDE TO THE MOUNTAIN IN ORDER TO DETERMINE TRANSPORTATION NEEDS! PARENTS STILL MUST PROVIDE SIGNATURE!**

**2. All students in Ski Club are required to have a BUDDY with them at all times! On the first day, students who are renting equipment and taking lessons from Greek Peak will be shown to the rental shop and the Ski School area by a buddy or a member of the chaperone team. Parents please sign up for group texting information via REMIND. To sign up, text this message: @nealmed to 81010, this is how we will communicate that we've left the mountain.**

**3. TIME SCHEDULE:** HS and MS Ski Club members will leave from the auditorium lot at the high school at 2:30pm, right after 9<sup>th</sup> period. Ski Club members in grades 3-5 will depart from the Elementary School at 3:30, or as soon as possible following school dismissal.

MS/HS Ski Club passes are good from 3:00 pm – 7:00 pm. DES Ski Club passes are good from 4:00 pm – 7:00 pm, and all students **MUST** be ready to load the bus at 7:30pm so that we can do a head count.

**The time schedule for departure from Greek Peak and student pick-up in Dryden is as follows:**

**7:15 pm - in Rental Shop, returning equipment**

**7:30 pm - at the bus, ready to board**

**7:45-8:00 - Students must be picked up at Dryden Elementary School**

**IF STUDENTS ARE LATE BOARDING THE RETURN BUS OR ARE PICKED UP LATE AT THE SCHOOL, STUDENT TRANSPORTATION PRIVILEGES WILL BE LOST THE FOLLOWING WEEK.**

**SKIING WILL BEGIN ON THURSDAY, JANUARY 9, 2020.  
Scheduled dates: Jan. 9th, 16th, 23rd, 30th, and Feb. 6<sup>th</sup> & 13th.**

#### 4. SIGN UP ONLINE:

All students must sign up and pay for a ski pass online directly from Greek Peak. Directions to sign up online are as follows:

- Access this website: <https://sales.greekpeak.net>
- Click on the link that says “Peak Pack/School Programs.”
- Click “Select your school,” and then click on the “Dryden” link.
- Select Dryden 6-12 or 4-5 depending on your grade. (if in 3rd, select 4-5)
- Select “Student Program Pass,” if you’re purchasing a Student Pass or “Season Pass Holder” if you already have a season pass and just need to ride the bus. Even if you don’t ride the bus, everyone needs to pay the club fee (TBD). Parents can also purchase a Parent Program Pass which allows them to ski on the same nights as their kids, and then turns into a season pass in early March. - You will then be prompted to choose whether or not you need to rent equipment, helmets, or want a meal plan. If you don’t need any of that, you need to click on add guest in the checkout window, and you’ll be prompted to fill out your personal information and pay. Every week we then receive notification from those that have paid.

Welcome to the 2020 season of Ski and Snowboarding with Dryden Central School!

The following are helpful and informational tips for your skier/boarder:

### **1. Appropriate clothing**

\*coat/jacket, snow pants, gloves or mittens (2 pair), non-cotton socks, balaclava (head/ neck warmer), non-cotton underclothing

### **2. Ski bag with boots, helmet, goggles**

This bag will be stored at school near the intermediate music room and will be transported by your child on the bus to Greek Peak so everything inside stays warm.

### **3. Skis/Snowboard**

This needs to be dropped off on Thursday mornings by 8:40 so the equipment truck can be loaded. If your child is renting equipment, we will help your child get his/her gear upon arrival to the mountain.

### **Day of Ski Club**

Bring gear to hooks (near music room - it's labeled) and leave equipment.

At dismissal (walker announcement) students go to bathroom and change into gear. They will need to be fully dressed minus ski/snowboard boots.

Meet in Mrs. Wojcik's classroom (170 third grade hall) with backpack, and ski bag.

We will take attendance in the classroom and again prior to boarding the bus.

Backpacks will be brought to the main office (on hooks) and will be collected upon return to the elementary school.

As close to 3:30 we will depart, so students must change quickly!

Once at Greek Peak, students will get a buddy.

Students must check in with Mrs. Wojcik between 5:45 and 6pm. If student does not check in he/she will lose the following week's ski privilege. This is for safety. Usually children choose to come in at this time to eat or warm up.

Students will come in at 7:20 to get ready to board busses for 7:30 departure.

Parent/Guardian must be at elementary school to pick up student between 7:45 and 8pm and come in to gather backpack and other student belongings.

- There are several chaperones and our co-advisor that are outside on the mountain skiing and boarding.
- I will remain inside the taverna (cafeteria...I show them all where I am) for the entire time of skiing unless there is an emergency and then I would be at ski patrol. I am available for questions and help.
